Workshop will set forth plans for county bike trail

Tulare County residents are invited to attend a workshop Thursday to share their ideas for the Santa Fe Trail - the county's first regional bicycle and multi-use trail.

The workshop will take place from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Prosperity Baptist Church, 1781 East Prosperity Avenue in Tulare.

The Santa Fe Trail will link Tulare and Visalia with a multi-use commuter and recreational trail following the historic Santa Fe Railroad corridor. It is funded through the transit, bike, and environmental portion of Measure R.

Measure R, the one-half cent sales tax passed in 2006, funds road improvements, transit and environmental improvements in Tulare County.

The Tulare County Association of Governments, acting as the Tulare County Transportation Authority, administers the Measure R program.
